Statistics and Methodology

There are three factors that determine the size of the confidence interval for a given confidence level: Sample size, Percentage and Population size

- POPULATION = 8500
- **SAMPLE SIZE = 1510**


• CONFIDENCE LEVEL = 95%

The confidence level tells you how sure you can be. It is expressed as a percentage and represents how often the true percentage of the population who would pick an answer lies within the confidence interval. The 95% confidence level means you can be 95% certain; the 99% confidence level means you can be 99% certain. Most researchers use the 95% confidence level.

CONFIDENCE INTERVAL = 1.92

The confidence interval (also called margin of error) is the plus-or-minus figure usually reported in newspaper or television opinion poll results. For example, if you use a confidence interval of 4 and 47% percent of your sample picks an answer you can be "sure" that if you had asked the question of the entire relevant population between 43% (47-4) and 51% (47+4) would have picked that answer.






FLAGLER BUSINESSES, NUMBER OF YEARS IN OPERATION





TOTAL NUMBER OF ESTABLISHMENTS




Question #4 Do you rent or own your business space?





Question #5 Is your business home-based?




Question #6 What is the ownership structure of your business?






Median number of employees



Average number of employees




Employer size based on number of employees




Question #8 Do you employ individuals other than your regular part-time and full-time employees?

Question #8a Detail of "Other Category" response






Question #9 What is the annual salary paid to your employees?




Part-time pay ranges






Question #10 Do you plan to expand operations within the next 6 months? Via investments in Equipment, Materials, Facility
